Survey Crew Chief

Job Responsibilities:

- Collects data for larger/complex boundaries, ALTA's and topographical survey.
- Has vast knowledge of/and operates total station, level, GPS receiver and data collectors to collect field data.
- Manages Rodman and Junior Crew Chief in the field and makes field decisions.
- Establishes and sets points on construction layout projects and can make field calculations when needed.
- Conducts daily maintenance and up-keep of instruments.
- Makes detailed sketches and records pertinent information in field book to accompany field data.
- Has good understanding of boundary computations, boundary law, survey history, Indiana codes and Land Title Survey requirements.
- Candidate must be able to work in a team environment and also be willing to work independently on occasion.

Qualifications/Requirements

- Two (2) years of Crew Chief experience or Associates Degree in Surveying.
- Must have experience with GPS, Robot Total Station, and data collections for land title surveys, construction layout, and topography.
- Experience with INDOT projects a plus.
- Ability to collect field data in an organized, neat and professional manner for various boundary, topographic, design and construction staking projects.
